Terms and Conditions

1. Expenses will be divided equally between the number of dogs exhibited, including the handler's, at each particular show or show weekend. This includes dogs brought to the show by their owners and/or dogs booked after the close of entries. Chargeable expenses can include gasoline, parking, hotel, airfare, rental car and miscellaneous dog expense for the handler and any assistants.
2. Client is responsible for making entries and paying all entry fees. Client is responsible for checking with the handler on a weekly basis to confirm which shows should be entered. As a standard business practice, handlers are responsible for choosing shows.
3. It is understood that client's failure to enter a dog for any reason (client forgets, entry service fails to get the entry in, entries get lost in the mail, etc) after verbally contracting the handler to show a dog for a specific show or shows, will result in assessment of full handling fees for said dog show(s). Fees will also be assessed in full if client pulls a dog after close of entries of within 24 hours of closing date for a given show. Extreme emergencies will be considered on a case by case basis.
4. It is understood that the owner of the dog will provide heartworm preventive and flea preventive products to the handler for their dog while it is under handler's care, along with instructions for use. Further, the owner is responsible for all costs incurred by the handler for any medical treatments or services by a veterinarian that are required for the dog while under the handler's care. It is further agreed that the handler shall determine the need for any veterinary care for the animal while under handler's supervision.
5. Dogs of all breeds prone to bloat (Gastric Dilatation & Volvulus) are required to be tacked (preventive gastropexy) after 1 year of age. For a list of breeds most at risk, see attached list.
6. It is the client's responsibility to advise the handler of any habits or special needs the dog may have that could possibly present a problem in giving safe and adequate care in the handler's facility or at the dog shows. It is also the client's responsibility to furnish instructions and medication if the dog is on medication of any kind. All clients are required to keep their dog's shots current per their vet's recommendation.
7. It is understood that in cases of ring conflicts, priority will be at the discretion of the handler. Owners that have supported the handler consistently and over the longest period of time will have priority. If necessary, a competent substitute handler will be secured to show your dog and the normal handling fee will be charged. In the event that no competent handler is available, the dog will be marked absent and no handling fee will be charged.
8. Payment is due and payable upon receipt of each invoice. All payments are expected to be made in full and received by the 10th of each month. A 10% late fee will be assessed on accounts 30 days past due. Any and all disputes regarding payment which cannot be agreed upon satisfactorily between client and handler will be settled in a court of law chosen by the handler. It is further agreed that client shall pay any and all reasonable legal fees and court costs should this action become necessary to collect any indebtedness. No dogs will be returned to owners unless their bill has been paid in full.
9. A \$ _____ deposit is required per dog and will be refunded with the final statement. It is understood that dogs will be returned only upon full payment of the bill.
